Here are some examples of the fantastic work produced by Geoffrey and Eli.

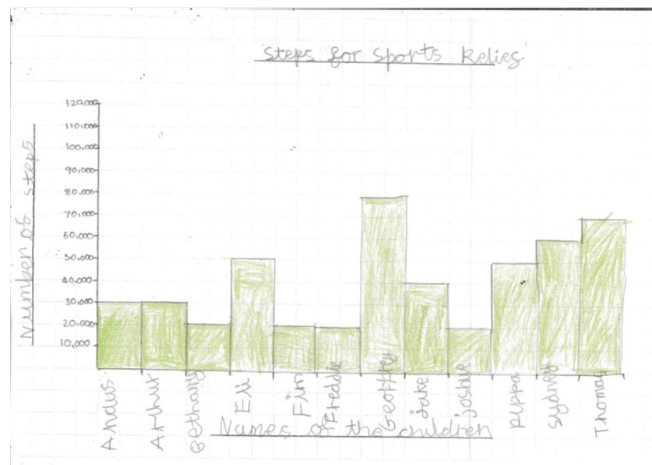
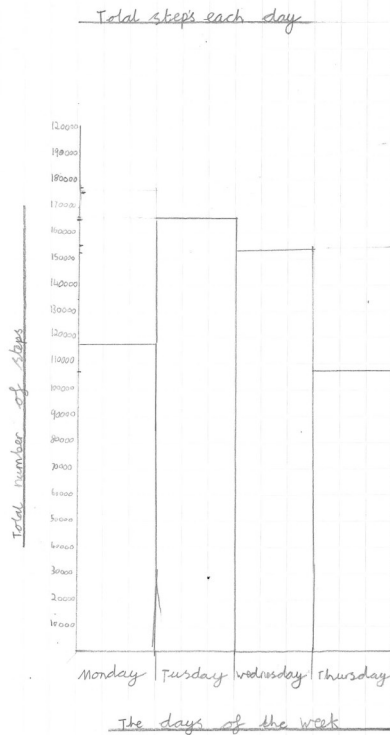
