

Topic

This term our topic is evolution!

We will link together the subjects of history, geography and science to study the life of Mary Anning.

The children will research the main fossil-hunting areas of the UK and learn about the 18th Century when Anning lived. This will culminate in a play about key events in Anning's life.

RE

For RE, we will enquire the question: 'what matters most to Christians, to humanists and to me?'

Maths

Year Six will now be revising for their KS2 SATS examination. They will cover the breadth of the KS2 syllabus to consolidate their existing knowledge.

Year Three and Four will cover the topics of addition and subtraction, money and time.

Art/DT

We will be completing a range of art activities linked in with our 'Animalium' focus text.

We will be experimenting with a range of different grade pencils and looking at aspects such as proportion and hatching.

Science

Our Science work will be focused around the topic of evolution

Year Six will be looking at different adaptations and studying famous scientists such as Darwin, Anning and Wallace.

Years Three and Four will be studying rock and fossil formations leading to the curation of their own display rock display.

English

This term, our focus texts will be around the theme of 'evolution'. The children will be studying the beautiful non-fiction text of 'Animalium' by Katie Scott and our classroom reader will be 'Beetle Boy' by M.G. Leonard. The children will be using these texts to create a variety of fiction and non-fiction writing.

PE

We will be continuing with our 'Real PE' scheme of work this term, focusing on the social aspect of PE.

Children will be expected to show patience and support others through a range of static balances and dynamic balances to agility movements.

The children will be focusing on relationships this term. This includes how to manage feelings and make the good decisions.
